

Number Snake

Cards to Use

Two sets of cards 1 - 10

How to Play

- Shuffle the two sets of cards together into one pile, facing down
- Each player takes 5 cards from the pile and holds them
- Take two more cards from the pile and put them next to each other, face up, in the middle of the table
- Players take turns trying to connect one of their cards to one of the cards on the table. If you have a card that is one less than one of the cards on the table, place it below that card. If you have a card that is one more than one of the cards on the table, place it above that card. (As the game goes on, you'll be building two number lines out of cards)
- If the player does not have any card that can connect to either of the two growing number "snakes," that player must take a card from the pile. If that card is one more or one less than one of the cards on the ends of the number snakes, it can be used immediately, otherwise the player must hold on to that card
- Eventually, one player will be able to use up all the cards in their hand
- The player who uses all the cards in their hand first wins
