HOW TO PLAY

Setup

- Cut out the three separate game boards below.
- Set the digital number spinner for the board you are using
- There are three levels of this game.
 - In level I, the game board is the shortest and the digital number spinner is set to make numbers from 1 to 5
 - In Level II, the board is slightly longer and numbers 1 to 9 are used
 - In level III, the board is much longer and numbers 1 through 19 are used


Gameplay

- Each player picks a side and places their ball at the goal.
- The two players take turns getting a number. The younger player draws a number first, and moves his/ her soccer ball that number of steps towards the other goal.
- The person wins by moving the soccer ball to the other person's goal

- Digital number spinner (http:// mingmath.com/ random)


